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### Exercise 1

Let  $a \in C_c^\infty(\mathbb{R}^d) \setminus \{0\}$  and  $m \in \mathbb{N}$ . Prove that the sequence

$$\phi_j(x) := e^{-j} j^m a(jx), \quad j \in \mathbb{N}, x \in \mathbb{R}^d,$$

converges in  $\mathcal{D}(\mathbb{R}^d)$ .

### Exercise 2

Let  $a \in C_c^\infty(\mathbb{R}^d) \setminus \{0\}$  and for  $j \in \mathbb{N}_+$  consider the sequences

$$\phi_j(x) := j^{-1} a(j^{-1}x), \quad \psi_j(x) := j^{-1} a(jx), \quad x \in \mathbb{R}^d.$$

Discuss the converge of such sequences in  $\mathcal{D}(\mathbb{R}^d)$ .

### Exercise 3

Give sufficient conditions on  $N \in \mathbb{R}$  in such a way that  $|x|^N \log |x| \in \mathcal{D}'(\mathbb{R}^d)$ .

### Exercise 4

Prove that  $(\log |x|)' = \text{P.V.} \frac{1}{x}$  in  $\mathcal{D}'(\mathbb{R})$ , where the principal value is defined by

$$\left(\text{P.V.} \frac{1}{x}\right)(\varphi) := \lim_{\varepsilon \rightarrow 0^+} \int_{|x| \geq \varepsilon} \frac{\varphi(x)}{x} dx, \quad \varphi \in \mathcal{D}(\mathbb{R}).$$

### Exercise 5

For  $\varepsilon > 0$  consider

$$g_\varepsilon(x) := \frac{1}{\pi} \frac{\varepsilon}{x^2 + \varepsilon^2}, \quad x \in \mathbb{R}.$$

Prove that  $g_\varepsilon \rightarrow \delta$  in  $\mathcal{D}'(\mathbb{R})$  as  $\varepsilon \rightarrow 0^+$ .

### Exercise 6

For  $\varepsilon > 0$  consider

$$f_\varepsilon(x) := (2\pi\varepsilon)^{-d/2} e^{-\frac{|x|^2}{2\varepsilon}}, \quad x \in \mathbb{R}^d.$$

Prove that  $f_\varepsilon \rightarrow \delta$  in  $\mathcal{D}'(\mathbb{R}^d)$  as  $\varepsilon \rightarrow 0^+$ .
